A) Who is CTEP and what CTEP has been doing for Cambodia?

<u>TEP Culture and Education Association (TEP)</u>, established in 2010, is an NGO from Taiwan dedicated to youth education, employment promotion and agriculture cooperation in Southeast Asia. Cambodia Team for Education Program Organization (CTEP), TEP's affiliate, is an NGO registered in Cambodia.

B) Summary of CTEP achievements

<u>Education Program</u>: Since 2010, a total of 32,027 students had graduated from the 36 Learning Centers set up or sponsored by CTEP in Cambodia.

<u>Employment Program</u>: Since 2015, more than 2,000 youth had found jobs or received vocational training with the help of CTEP.

<u>Agriculture Program</u>: Since 2018, five groups totaling 48 Cambodians were invited to Taiwan for study, training or exhibition.
